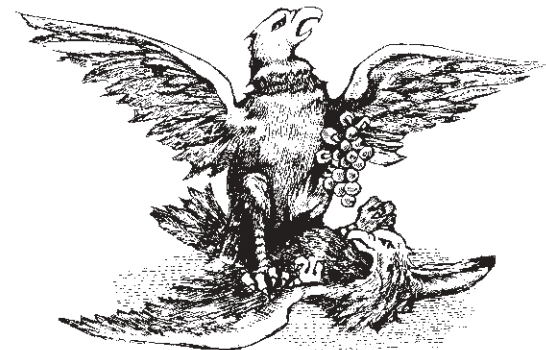

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A little tight on the attack, this a good wine that grows on you through the palate. Well-knitted black fruits, cassis bud and cigar box notes. Just 3,3hl/h yield because the frost really devastated the vineyard. But the estate has managed to bring out a tiny amount of good wine, even if it bears some of the scars of the frost. There is a lovely texture, bright fruits, although it just stops a little short, so make the most of it over the next five to ten years.

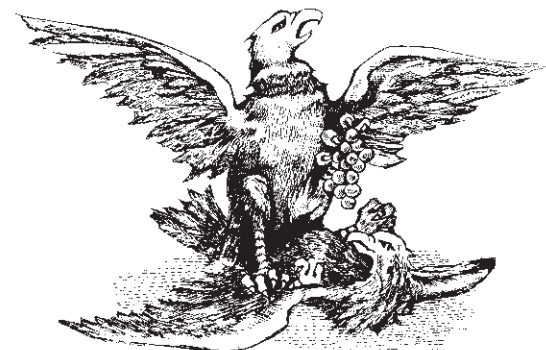
The estate puts a lot of work into biodiversity, and it is engaged in organic conversion with Ecocert.
